DRURY? OR DON'T WE? Joanne Wicker



- The convention was developed by Canadian
 Douglas Drury and his then playing partner Eric
 Murry to manage Murray's propensity to open light in third seat
- Opening light in the third seat is a common and effective bidding tactic
- A third seat light opening will act preemptively to make it harder for the opponents to enter the bidding



Two Way Reverse Drury ("Bergen" Drury)		
Auction	Meaning	
P - (P) - 1H/S - (P); 2C - (P) -	2C is artificial, showing 10-12 points and exactly 3 card trump support. The bid asks partner, who opened with a major in third-seat partner, to respond according to the following conventional agreement:	
P - (P) - 1H/S - (P); 2D - (P) -	2D is artificial, showing 10-12 points and 4+ trump support. The bid asks partner, who opened with a major in third-seat partner, to respond according to the following conventional agreement:	
Opener Rebids		
2 Hearts/Spades	Warns inviting partner that third seat opener was made with sub-opening values, asking partner to make a signoff bid in two of partner's major suit.	
2 Diamonds ("Slow Shows" values)	Provides partner a positive response that third seat opener was based on a true opening hand, advising partner to pick the best game contract.	



Two-Way Reverse Drury is a variation of the Drury convention. It allows a passed hand to show 3- and 4-card limit raises after partner opens 1♥ or 1♠. After partner opens 1♥/♠ in third or fourth seat, responder's bids are as follows.

Response to 1♥/♠	Meaning
2.	Artificial, 10-12 points with exactly 3-card support
2	Artificial, 10-12 points with 4+ card support

2 🍁	A sound opening bid (12+ points)	
2♥	A weak hand (10-12 points)	
All other bids	Natural, with normal opening values (12+ points)	



After opening 1♥ and a 2♦ response:

Opener's Rebid	Meaning
2♥	A weak hand (10-12 points)
All other bids	Natural, with normal opening values (12+ points)



After opening 1♠ and a 2♣ response:

Meaning
A sound opening bid
Natural, 4+ hearts, but does not guarantee a full opening bid
A weak hand
Natural, with normal opening values



After opening 1♠ and a 2♦ response:

Opener's Rebid	Meaning
2♥	Natural, 4+ hearts, but does not guarantee a full opening bid
2♠	A weak hand
All other bids	Natural, with normal opening values

- 2. Showing minimum strength. (Playing "normal" Drury, this would show a sound opening bid.)

- 2. Natural, promising sound opening strength.
- 3. Bidding game with a good club fit.
